The Supreme Court of the Virgin Islands wishes to remind the general public and members of the Virgin Islands Bar Association that effective November 2, 2011, the Virgin Islands Supreme Court will implement mandatory e-filing of all documents pursuant to the proposed Rules of the Supreme Court. The documents that will be required to be e-filed include, but are not limited to Notices of Appeal, Briefs, attorneys' requests for Certificates of Good Standing, motions, petitions and applications for admissions to the Virgin Islands Bar.

In order to facilitate the mandatory use of the Virgin Islands Supreme Court Electronic Filing System ("VISCEFS"), the Court has established a training schedule for both *pro se* litigants and members of the Virgin Islands Bar on both islands. Attending members of the Virgin Islands Bar Association will receive one (1) Continuing Legal Education (CLE) credit hour for their participation in the training.
