The Supreme Court of the Virgin Islands wishes to advise the general public and members of the Virgin Islands Bar Association that effective October 24, 2011, the Virgin Islands Supreme Court Electronic Filing System ("VISCEFS") will be available on the Court's website, www.visupremecourt.org, with limited accessibility to allow members of the Virgin Islands Bar and *pro se* litigants to register as e-filing users in preparation of the launching of VISCEFS on November 2, 2011.

In accordance with proposed Virgin Islands Supreme Court Rule 40.2(b), all attorneys regularly or specially admitted to practice before the Supreme Court, as well as all applicants for regular admission are required to register as Filing Users of VISCEFS. Proposed VISCR 40.2(2) provides that parties proceeding *pro* se who are not members of the Virgin Islands Bar may, but are not required, to e-file documents.

Persons electing to register as e-filing users will be notified electronically of their approval status on November 2, 2011 when VISCEFS is implemented.
