**ORDER TEMPORARILY EXTENDING
TERM OF SPECIAL ADMISSION FOR
SPECIALLY ADMITTED ATTORNEYS
ADMITTED UNDER PRIOR RULES
WHO SAT FOR THE JULY 2011 VIRGIN
ISLANDS BAR EXAMINATION.**

ORDER OF THE COURT

This Court, pursuant to the authority granted to it by section 21(c) of the Revised Organic Act of 1954, as amended, and title 4, sections 32(e), 32(f)(2), and 34(a) of the Virgin Islands Code, as well as its inherent authority, promulgated Supreme Court Rule 202(e)(1), which authorized individuals who had been specially admitted, for less than ten years, to the Virgin Islands Bar under special admission rules that had been in effect prior to September 1, 2007, to continue to practice as special admitted attorneys through September 1, 2011. Recognizing that the results of the July 2011 Virgin Islands Bar Examination will not be released prior to September 1, 2011, it is hereby

ORDERED that, notwithstanding Supreme Court Rule 202(e)(1), a special admittee who sat for the July 2011 Virgin Islands Bar Examination may continue to practice as a specially admitted attorney through December 31, 2011, provided that the special admittee remains employed as an attorney by the petitioning agency and otherwise continues to satisfy the requirements necessary to maintain his or her special admission. It is further

ORDERED that copies of this order be directed to the appropriate parties.
