The Supreme Court of the Virgin Islands advises the general public and members of the Virgin Islands Bar that due to the inclement weather conditions on the island of St. Croix and resulting leaks in some critical areas, the Court will cease its operations on St. Croix today at 10:00 a.m. All filings will continuously be accepted electronically via the Court's electronic filing system ("VICEFS").

Additionally, filings will be accepted for non-electronic filers via a secured lockbox at the entrance of the Supreme Court's premises at No. 18 Strand Street, Frederiksted, St. Croix. The Court's St. Thomas office located at No. 161B Crown Bay will operate under regularly scheduled hours.

The general public and members of the Virgin Islands Bar are encouraged to call the office in St. Thomas at (340) 774-2237, should they require assistance. The Supreme Court anticipates resuming its normal operation in St. Croix on Monday, November 10, 2014.
