The Supreme Court of the Virgin Islands advises the general public and members of the Virgin Islands Bar that the Court's facilities located at No. 18 Strand Street, Frederiksted, on the island of St. Croix will cease its operations at 3:00 p.m. today. The closure is due to water interruptions to that location caused by ongoing construction in the nearby area. All filings will continuously be accepted electronically via the Court's electronic filing system ("VICEFS").

Additionally, filings will be accepted for non-electronic filers via a secured lockbox at the entrance of the Supreme Court's premises at No. 18 Strand Street, Frederiksted, St. Croix. The Court's St. Thomas office located at No. 161B Crown Bay will operate under regularly scheduled hours. The general public and members of the Virgin Islands Bar are encouraged to call the office in St. Thomas at (340) 774-2237, should they require assistance.

The office will resume normal business hours on Wednesday, May 25, 2016.
